



His honour, valour, duty and sacrifice were paramount and sacrosanct. He exemplified the values of self-reliance, self-respect and respect for mankind.


Rabindranath Tagore MOTTO- Nurture the culture

He imbibe the qualities of peace and perseverance to the world. He urged students to explore intellectual self-reliance and freedom.


Sardar Patel MOTTO- Integrity Reigns

Dear Parents/Guardians

We request you to extend your full cooperation in the education of your child. For the best result, all three of us you, your child and the school must work together. Therefore, you are expected to cooperate with school authorities.

- You are advised to check the uniform and studies of your child. For the same you will be informed by periodic reports sent to you. You should sign all the reports and notes sent to you in order to show that you have seen the remarks.
- 2. You should come to collect reports whenever called to do so, particularly on the last working day of every month (P.T.M.)
- 3. You can meet the teachers on all working Saturdays of the year (except Examination Days) between 2.00 to 2.30 p.m.
- 4. Parents can meet the Principal with prior appointment between 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 p.m.
- 5. Birthday parties in school are not permitted.
- 6. Student are not allowed to come in casuals on their birthday.
- 7. Your child must carry his/her I card everyday.

8. Attendance

The academic session is divided into two terms:

(April to September and October to March.)

- a) Leave will be granted only on receipt of application from parents or guardians. Students who remain absent without sanctioned leave must bring a note of satisfactory explanation from their parents/guardians.
- b) After holidays (Summer, Dussehra, Diwali, Winter) students should be present on the day scheduled for the re-opening of school.
- c) Your child will not be allowed to leave school for any reason once he/she is marked as "Present", unless it is a medical emergency.
- **9.** Parents are advised to keep a regular check on their ward's activities, school diary school uniform etc.
- 10. You are advised to check the uniform and studies of your child for the same you will be informed by periodic reports sent to you. You should sign all the reports and notes sent to you in order to show that you have seen the remarks.
- 11. Any appointment with the teacher/Principal, should be informed in advance through the student diary, parents are advised to respect the slot given to meet the concerned teacher stated by the institution.
- **12.** Parents should drop their ward at the school gate by 7.55 am sharp.
- **13.** Please meet the Principal or a teacher whenever you receive a note or a phone call regarding your ward's problem.
- 14. Parents are requested to ensure that their ward carries the text/exercise books according to the time table, absence of which add excess weight and harms the spine of the child.
- 15. No student is allowed to come to school in self driven vehicle other than a bicycle. The bicycle must be parked at the parking place in school premises and must be locked.

- 16. The criticism of the teachers or the institution in the presence of their children should be scrupulously avoided because it may cause loss of respect to their teacher as well as the school, further retard his progress.
- **17.** Payment of fee is the responsibility of the parent and it should be paid on time.
- **18.** Students who fail to show the remarks / test report and get them countersigned by their parents are liable to be sent home.
- **19.** We expect you to attend all parents teacher meetings. This is your opportunity to help us to improve.
- 20. Parents are requested to instill the habit of sending home made food in students lunch box, Junk food is totally prohibited in the school.
- 21. You are advised to be properly dressed up in formal clothes, when visiting school.

22 School Leaving Certificate

School leaving certificate will be issued only on receipt of the application from the parents or guardians. Such application should be given one month before the intended withdrawl, failing which, one month's tuition fee will be charged.

23. Change in Particulars

- a) Parents should intimate the incharge / reception for any change in Date of Birth, Surname of the child with valid proof.
- b) If there is a change of address or phone number, please intimate the class teacher at the earliest in writing.

24. Promotion Policy

Promotion to the higher class shall be made as per rules and regulations prescribed by C.B.S.E. from time to time.

25. For security reasons no tiffin, boxes/water bottles or any other articles will be accepted at the Reception for delivery to the students.

26. School Fee

- a)School fee is to be paid quarterly (April June), (July Sept.), (Oct. Dec.), (Jan. March)
- b) Fee is to be paid in advance by the 20th of the first month of the quarter at any ICICI Bank Branch in Delhi.
- c) In case of withdrawl of a child, a month's notice in writing is to be given or a month's tuition fee will be charged.
- d)Fees will not be refunded under any circumstances, once the student is admitted to the school.

School Rules/Code of Conduct

- 1. It is mandatory for all the students to bring their school diary daily.
- 2. Students shall come to school on time and neatly dressed up in proper school uniform.
- 3. Students should reach the school before the first bell rings. The school gate will be closed after the first bell.
- **4.** Students should bring their books and notebook properly labeled & as per the time table.
- 5. Students are not allowed to make or receive any phone call from the school. Urgent messages will be communicated to them. Students are not allowed to carry mobile phones inside the school premises. If a student brings a mobile phone to school, it will be confiscated.
- **6.** Minimum 75% attendance is compulsory for each student to be eligible for any type of assessment conducted by the school for a session.
- **7.** Being a co-education school, it is expected that the dignity of every student is maintained.
- 8. Damage to school property will be subject to disciplinary action.
- **9.** The school reserves the right to suspend/expel students whose conduct is harmful to other students or to the school.

- 10. No student is allowed to come to school in self driven vehicle other than a bicycle. The bicycles must be parked at the parking place in school premises and must be locked.
- **11.** No student shall leave the classroom without permission.
- **12.** No Half days/Short leave is permitted for any reason except emergency. In that case, parents need to give an application and should personally take their ward from the school.
- 13. Long absence without information may result in the students name being struck off, sick leave for more than two days would be sanctioned only after producing a medical certificate from the doctor or concerned medical officer.
- 14. For security reasons no tiffin, boxes/water bottles or any other articles will be accepted at the Reception for delivery to the students.
- 15. Children should not bring any valuable articles like expensive watches, jewellery etc to school and any violation to this will be subject to disciplinary action decided by the school Discipline Committee. In case of any loss of articles, the school shall not undertake any responsibility for the loss.
- 16. Mobile phones are strictly prohibited in the school. Students, if caught with the cell phones, will have to face strict disciplinary action including suspension and fine, and phone will be confiscated.
- **17.** Etiquette, habits of obedience, order and neatness in dress and above all punctuality are required at all times.
- **18.** Students are advised to keep the surroundings neat and clean.
- 19. The school reserves the right to add, alter and cancel any rule given in this diary at any time at its discretion which will be binding to the student and their parents/guardians.


