




### About Us



A program was conducted to commemorate the 200th birth anniversary of Dayanand ji , where his teachings were remembered . Langar was distributed among children and teachers.




















### First Day Of School




## World Health Day This day was celebrated to promote awareness of global health issues and encourage students to adopt healthy habits.

This activity is used as a fun, Hands-on way to teach young students about different topics such as motor skills ,creativity ,or emotional lessons.




















School organize Rakhi - Making activity where students create their own Rakhi's using materials like ribbon, beads etc. and understand the significance of this festival.














### Sharing is Power































### Grand Parents' Day Celebration














## Shapes Contour Activity
